# SRB of the Year

The ASID SRB of the Year award recognizes a Student Representative to the Board who has demonstrated exemplary dedication to his or her position, and service to his or her chapter.

## Nominations

The SRB of the Year is selected through a nomination process. Student chapter presidents, professional chapter presidents, student affairs chairs, and ASID Student Advisory Council members are eligible to nominate candidates. Once a candidate is nominated, he or she will receive notification of the nomination and will be asked to provide supporting documentation, including letters of recommendation and a personal statement. The winner is then chosen from the completed applications. The winner of this award will be asked to submit a headshot for publicity purposes. # Outstanding Student Chapter of the Year

The ASID Outstanding Student Chapter of the Year award recognizes a single ASID student chapter that has provided exceptional service to its student members, professional associates and community.

## Applications

To apply for this award, the student chapter president or appointed chair should develop a student chapter "portfolio." This portfolio outlines the chapter's outstanding qualities, notable projects, accomplishments and goals. Portfolios may contain up to seven items.

Examples include

- Student chapter strategic plan (this item is required and MUST be included)
- Essay on student involvement with the professional chapter
- Sample newsletters
- Descriptions of successful fundraisers
- Descriptions of notable programs, events, speakers, trips, etc.
- Sample meeting announcement
- Essay on a specific challenge the chapter has overcome
- Letters of recommendation from faculty members, Industry Partner representatives, professional chapter officers, professional liaison or other affiliated ASID professionals
- Additional information you would like to share

All submissions must include a completed application and must be typed. Photographs may be submitted, preferably in JPEG format on a CD. Correct ASID branding standards and use of the ASID logo is required in all communications.
