WELL

WELL believes that buildings should be developed with people's health and wellness at the center of design. The WELL Building Standard®, administered by the International WELL Building Institute® (IWBI), is an evidence-based system for measuring, certifying, and monitoring the performance of building features that impact health and well-being.

WELL is grounded in a body of medical research that explores the connection between the buildings where we spend more than 90 percent of our time, and the health and wellness impacts on us as occupants. WELL Certified TM developments can help create a built environment that improves the nutrition, fitness, mood, sleep patterns, and performance of its occupants.

By placing people at the heart of design, construction, operations, and development decisions, we have the ability to add meaningful value to real estate assets, generate savings in personnel costs, and enhance the occupant's health and well-being.

WELL features are categorized as either Preconditions—necessary for baseline WELL Certification, or Optimizations—optional enhancements, which together determine the level of certification above baseline certification. Certification levels include Certified, Silver, Gold, and Platinum.

LEED

LEED, or Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design, is a certification program for buildings and communities that guides their design, construction, operations and maintenance toward sustainability. It's based on prerequisites and credits that a project meets to achieve a certification level: Certified, Silver, Gold and Platinum.

LEED certification means healthier, more productive places, reduced stress on the environment by encouraging energy and resource-efficient buildings, and savings from increased building value, higher lease rates, and decreased utility costs.



The Net-Works program enables fishing communities in developing countries to sell discarded fishing nets back into a global supply chain and provides a continuous source of recycled materials for use in carpet tile production. Local residents have so far collected more than 80 metric tons of discarded fishing nets for reuse that would otherwise damage the oceans. 
